On September 14, 2011 a search was conducted at the residence located at 502 Dunning Street, Madison, Wisconsin. The search was pursuant to a search warrant issued on September 13, 2011 by the Honorable Neal Netteshein, Milwaukee County Circuit Court Judge, First Judicial District of Wisconsin. The search was conducted by agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), together with Investigators from the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office (MCDA) and Investigators from the Dane County District Attorney's Office (DCDA).

The search began at approximately 6:44 A.M. when entry was made by means of agents/investigators knocking and announcing their official purpose; access was granted by the owner and occupant of the residence, CYNTHIA ARCHER. Also present in the residence at the time of the search was NATALIE FEGGESTAD, white female, date of birth November 25, 1971. The warrant was read aloud to ARCHER by Investigator AARON WEISS, Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office in accordance with Wisconsin law.

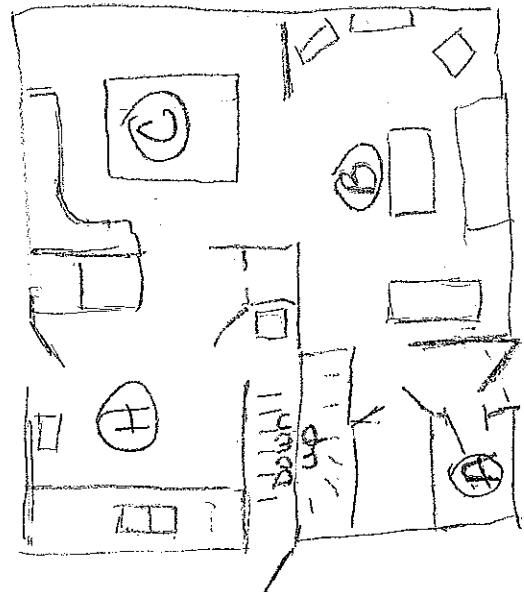

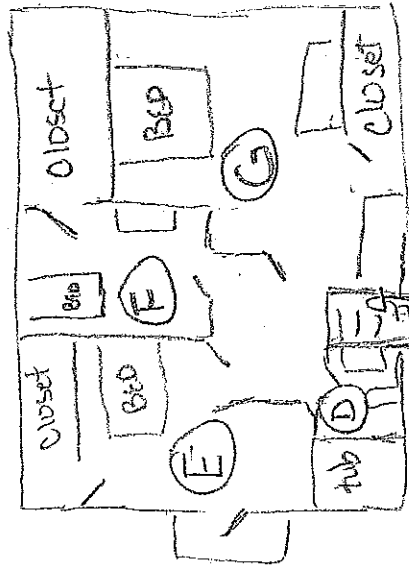

Main Floor

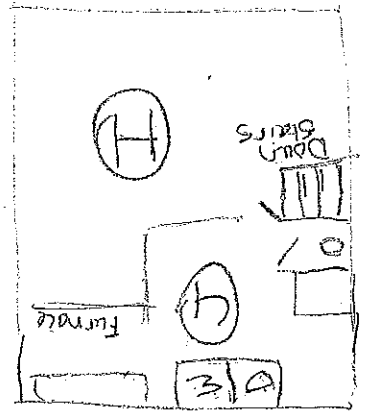


Dunning Street
